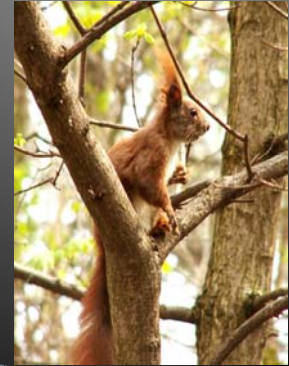

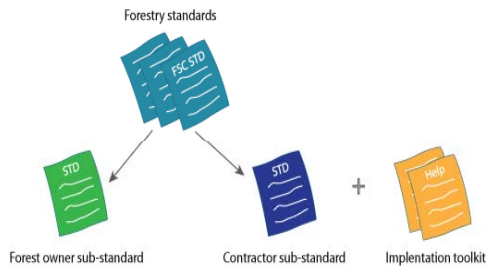

-Denmark: (presented by Jan Peter Feil). Current status: Drafts of the 2 substandards (one for landowners and one for contractors) are in public consultation.

-Sweden: (presented by Kjell- Owe Ahlskog). Current status: Communications meeting are still happening to understand better the interest of the project in Sweden.

-Spain (presented by Leticia Calvo Vialettes). Current status: The Spain Project begins on April 2010, analyze, meeting and division of substandards are still happening.

-Portugal (presented by Rui Simoes). Current status: 5 meetings since February 2010 in Lisboa, Portugal. List of indicators completed and translated into English. Division of responsibilities partially done.

-Bulgaria (Presented by Jan Peter Feil).Current status: communication meetings are still happening.
